Jerseys and Colors

There will be two different colors (red and blue). We will be doing an assessment first two weeks so when can split the kids up evenly. When we split into two teams we will divide them into a red and blue team. The hat will be a standard navy blue that will go with either color.

Blue Jays - Tee Ball Levels A - Co-ed

At this level the intentions are to enforce the basic concepts of hitting, fielding, and to introduce base running. Additionally, we want to coach and play in such a way where the kids have fun and are relaxed around a baseball coming towards them.

Beavers - Rookies (Tee Ball Level B) - Co-ed

End of Season Goal

- How to stand and swing a bat
- How to throw the ball accurately to teammates
- Begin to understand the idea of hitting the ball and running to a base

Rules

- Every player bats and plays in the field.
- The ball is hit off a batting tee; there is no pitching.
- There are no walks or strikeouts.
- The ball must travel 10 feet or it is a foul.
- No fielder may cross the playing line until the ball is hit.
- No stealing. Player stays on the base until the ball is hit.
- An inning is over when all the players have batted once.
- Standard game is four innings.
- Scores are not kept at this age level

- 1st Base
- 2nd Base
- 3rd Base
- Modified Centerfield (ten feet behind and between 1st and 2nd Base)
- Modified Shortstop (closer to where the pitcher would traditionally be)
- Modified Right field (closer)*
- Modified Right field (closer)*

*Expendable if there are not enough players

Equipment

- Safety helmets must be worn.
- Bats 25"/26" long & 21/4" diameter, max. 17 to 20 ounces.
- Ball 9" to 91/2" around; 4 to 5 ounces. (Softer than a standard baseball)

Field

- 50 feet between the bases.
- A real or imaginary playing line is between first base and third base or an
- arc 40 feet from home plate.

- An inning is over when all the players have batted once.
- Standard game is six inning game should not last longer than an hour.
- No game should go beyond six innings.
